"New" Fifth Hole

Pebble Beach founder Samuel F. B. Morse's lifelong regret was his sale of the land upon which you now stand. The result was that for the first 79 years of its life, the course turned inland to the par three fifth and a private residence stood on this spot.

In 1997, Taiheiyo Club, the owner of Pebble Beach Company from 1992 to 1999, with the help of Sumitomo Bank, was able to reacquire this property and complete Morse's vision. Of the many improvements made to Pebble Beach by these owners, none will be more fondly remembered.

In recognition of their thoughtful and caring ownership of one of our country's national treasures, this hole was dedicated on June 8, 2000.

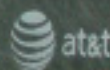
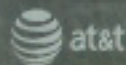
